October

How do you feel about being entrusted with resources and talents by God? Do you feel like the servant with five bags, two or one?

What does it mean to you to put your resources and abilities to work? What do you expect to gain from this? Where have you seen that happen, and where are you waiting for it to happen?

"The man who had received five bags of gold went at once and put his money to work and gained five bags more. So also, the one with two bags of gold gained two more."

Where do you feel like you might be letting your resources or abilities stay hidden or remain unused? What would you like to change about this?

Monday



As you begin a new working week, who do you work for? Do you think it might make a difference if you consciously work for God in your everyday jobs?

This can feel like a difficult verse to interpret fairly! What do you think it means? (One approach – imagine it's not about money or God-given abilities, but about faith and a willingness to put talents and beliefs into practice. How much do you think you have? How

much would you like, and how do you think you could get more?)

"Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters, since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward."

When you think about working and using your abilities, how do you balance satisfying yourself and serving others? What are the best ways you can think of to do both at the same time? Could these be the best possible uses of the abilities God has given you?
